**AGENDA TEXT:** BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS APPOINTMENT – A request to approve the appointment of Mollie Shepardson to the Fruita Tourism Advisory Council (FTAC) for a three-year term to expire in January of 2028

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### BACKGROUND

On September 17, 2024, Fruita Tourism Advisory Council (FTAC) member Libbie Early resigned from the board, thus creating a vacancy. On September 4, 2024, Mollie Shepardson submitted her application for appointment to the FTAC, which is attached. The vacancy has been advertised since January of 2024 and one other application was received by staff in addition to Ms. Shepardson's application for the vacant seat on the board.

On December 3, 2024, Mayor Breman and Council Liaison Rich Parrish interviewed both applicants and subsequently recommend that Mollie Shepardson be appointed to the FTAC for a three-year term to expire in January of 2028.

If Mollie Shepardson is reappointed, there will be no remaining vacancies on the FTAC.

Finally, pursuant to the City's Boards and Commissions policies, Mollie will be term-limited to one additional three-year term if she is reappointed at this time.
