

**RESOLUTION 2025-08**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, CITY OF FRUITA, TOWN OF PALISADE, AND COUNTY OF MESA, COLORADO FOR THE FY 2024 SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) SUPPLEMENTAL PLANNING AND DEMONSTRATION GRANT.**

**WHEREAS**, the Fruita City Council finds it necessary for the City of Fruita to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Grand Junction, City of Fruita, Town of Palisade, (collectively the “Cities”) and County of Mesa (“County”), Colorado for the FY 2024 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Supplemental Planning and Demonstration Grant, and

**WHEREAS**, the County and Municipalities submitted a joint US Department of Transportation Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant application on August 29, 2024, and

**WHEREAS**, the County and Municipalities were selected for an award of \$196,000 in federal funding from the FY 2024 SS4A Grant Program for Supplemental Planning and Demonstration, and

**WHEREAS**, the County has agreed to serve as the fiscal agent for the FY 2024 SS4A Supplemental Planning and Demonstration Grant, and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of this Resolution to authorize the Mayor to enter into the Memorandum of Agreement for the purposes of the grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRUITA CITY COUNCIL THAT:**

**Section 1:** The above Recitals are true and correct.

**Section 2:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and sign the attached Memorandum of Agreement.
