BACKGROUND

Public Works professionals focus on infrastructure, facilities and services that are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health, high quality of life and well-being of the people of the City of Fruita.

This year's national theme is "Ready and Resilient" which adequately describes the men and women who work in the Public Works Department. The City of Fruita Public Works Department is responsible for street maintenance, traffic safety, sewer utilities (including collection system and treatment plant, irrigation, and mountain water), facilities, and fleet services. They are responsible for maintaining, rebuilding, and protecting our critical infrastructure.
