AGENDA TEXT: Mesa County Ordinance for Licensing and Regulations of Marijuana Businesses.

BACKGROUND

In November 2021, the voters of Mesa County passed Ballot Measure 1A which overrides County Ordinance 11 and allows certain marijuana businesses in accordance with the Colorado Marijuana Code. Since the passing of Ballot Measure 1A, Mesa County has been working to amend their Land Development Code for the purposes of authorizing the licensing of certain marijuana businesses in unincorporated Mesa County.

The purpose of this item is to inform the City Council on the upcoming Ordinance proposed to the Board of County Commissioners (attached with this Coversheet).
