AGENDA TEXT: BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS APPOINTMENT – A request to approve the appointment of Chriss Rusch to the Planning Commission for a three-year term to expire in July of 2025

BACKGROUND

In June of 2022, Planning Commission member Justin Gollob's term expired. On April 20, 2022, Mr. Gollob sent an email to staff stating that he did not wish to seek reappointment for another term, thus creating a vacancy. The vacancy was advertised on the City's website at fruita.org and on the City's Facebook page between April 1, 2022 and the present.

On May 17, 2022, staff received an application from Chriss Rusch for a seat on the Planning Commission. On June 20, 2022, Mayor Kincaid and Board Liaison Councilor Amy Miller interviewed Mr. Rusch and subsequently recommended that he be appointed to the Planning Commission for a three-year term.

Mr. Rusch's application is attached for the Council's review.
