AGENDA TEXT: BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS REAPPOINTMENT – A request to approve the reappointment of Derek Biddle to the Planning Commission as a regular member for a three-year term to expire in September of 2026

BACKGROUND

Derek Biddle's term on the Planning Commission expired in August of 2023, thus creating a vacancy. An alternate member vacancy has been advertised on the City's website at fruta.org and on the City's Facebook page since April 17, 2023 to the present, but staff has received no applications.

On August 10, 2023, Derek Biddle submitted his application for reappointment to a three-year vacancy on the Planning Commission. Mayor Joel Kincaid and Council Liaison Amy Miller recommend that he be reappointed to the Planning Commission for a three-year term that will expire in September of 2026.

Mr. Biddle's application is attached for the Council's review. If he is reappointed, there will be one remaining alternate member vacancy on the Planning Commission, for which staff will continue to advertise.

OPTIONS AVAILABLE TO THE COUNCIL
