AGENDA TEXT: RESOLUTION 2026-07 –A Request to Approve a Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into an Agreement with Axon Enterprise, Inc for a Five-Year Term

BACKGROUND

The purpose of this Resolution is to authorize the City Manager to sign an agreement with Axon Enterprise, Inc for a five-year term. This agreement will renew our terms with Axon for body-worn cameras and storage of the videos through Evidence.com. Axon cameras are used by all law enforcement agencies in Mesa County, to include the Grand Junction Police Department, Mesa County Sheriff's Office, Palisade Police Department, Colorado State Patrol and the District Attorney's Office. So, through Evidence.com we are able to share and receive videos and photographs with other agencies. Additionally, the D.A.'s Office has purchased transcribing features for Axon body-worn cameras that it uses for criminal cases. This service would not be available with another company or would be an additional cost.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Contract is for a five-year period. The annual billable amount is \$39,474.00. For signing a multi-year agreement, The City of Fruita would be saving an average of \$9,422.64 per year which totals \$47,113.20 for the term of the contract in savings.

By receiving services from Axon Enterprises, Inc., The City of Fruita enhances transparency and facilitates coordination with other local governments.
