RESOLUTION FHA 2025-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE FRUITA HOUSING AUTHORITY AMENDING THE 2024 BUDGET WITH SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF FUNDS FOR A PASS-THROUGH GRANT FROM THE COLORADO ENERGY OFFICE TO THE FRUITA MEWS DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the Fruita Housing Authority (FHA) was created by the Fruita City Council for the purpose of acting as a single-limited partner (SLP) in Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (LITC) workforce housing projects, including the Fruita Mews project; and

WHEREAS, the FHA has entered into agreements with the developers of the Fruita Mews to act as a pass-through for certain grants, including funds from the Colorado Energy Office's HEEHA program, for tax purposes; and

WHEREAS, the FHA needs to appropriate these grants funds to pass them through to the developer of the project.

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Fruita Housing Authority certifies there are sufficient funds available for the supplemental appropriations as noted below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRUITA HOUSING AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the 2024 appropriation for the Fruita Housing Authority is hereby increased by \$1,055,525 from \$55,100 to \$1,060,625 from the following sources for the following uses:
