

Boards and Commissions Vacancies October through December 2023 (updated September 19, 2023)

The City of Fruita is looking for citizen volunteers residing within Fruita city limits who are interested in serving on the following Boards and Commissions. Board of Adjustment (two vacancies: two alternate member vacancies for three-year terms each)

• Hears appeals from any order, decision, requirements or interpretation made by the City Planner, hears applications on variances. Meets on an "as needed" basis at the Fruita Civic Center.

<u>Historic Preservation Board</u> (one regular member vacancy for a three-year term)

 Makes recommendations to the City Council concerning Land Use applications in accordance with the requirements of the City's Land Use Code Title 17 of the Fruita Municipal Code. Meets on the first Monday of the month at 11:00 am at the Fruita Civic Center.

<u>Parks and Recreation Advisory Board</u> (two vacancies: one regular member vacancy to fulfill an unexpired term and one regular member vacancy for a three-year term)

Recommends plans for acquisitions, development and operations of parks, recreation areas and facilities
and recommends recreational programs. Meets on the first Monday of the month at 5:30 p.m. at the Fruita
City Shops at 900 E. Keifer.

Police Commission (two vacancies: two regular member vacancies for three-year terms)

• Recommends policies, standards, procedures and limitation for the Police Department to the City Council. Meets on the third Wednesday of the month quarterly at 6:00 pm at the Police Services Building.

<u>Arts and Culture Board</u> (one vacancy: one regular member vacancy to fulfill an unexpired term plus an additional three-year term to expire in December of 2026)

• To create and enhance art and culture in the City of Fruita.

<u>Downtown Advisory Board</u> (seven vacancies: seven regular member vacancies for three-year terms each)

• To bring the resources of the downtown community together to maintain, enhance and promote the downtown as the social and cultural center of the City of Fruita. The board will address issues such as parking, lighting, landscaping, diversity of retail opportunities, pedestrian needs, design standards, zoning, vehicle circulation, facilities such as arts and incubator centers, critical infrastructure, and organizational/implementation needs. Meets on the second Wednesday of the month at 6:00 pm at the Fruita Civic Center.

<u>Livability Commission</u> eleven vacancies: one student vacancy for a one-year term and ten regular member vacancies for three-year terms each)

• Supports healthy aging and improving the quality of life, economic health and lifestyle of the Fruita Community. Meets on the third Thursday of the month at 4:00 pm at the Fruita Civic Center.
