AGENDA TEXT: BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS APPOINTMENT – A request to approve

the appointment of Connie Overton to the Livability Commission to fulfill

an unexpired term that will expire in March of 2024

BACKGROUND

The membership guidelines of the Livability Commission call for a minimum of seven and a maximum of twenty-one members. There are currently eight members on the board, so there is the potential for thirteen (13) vacancies on the board. Staff has advertised these vacancies on the City's website and Facebook page for over a year and a half and will continue to do so.

On April 22, 2022, Connie Overton submitted her application for appointment. City staff has not received any other applications. Mayor Kincaid and Council Liaison to the board Jeannine Purser interviewed Ms. Overton on May 17, 2022 and subsequently recommend her appointment to the board to fulfill an unexpired term to expire in March of 2021.

If Connie Overton is appointed, there is still the potential for twelve (12) remaining vacancies on the board.
