BACKGROUND

Sales, Use Tax and Lodging Tax Revenues – June 2021 Sales.

The following chart provides a comparison of sales, use and lodging tax revenues between 2020 and 2021. Overall tax revenues are up \$742,973 from the prior year and ahead of budgeted amounts by \$901,611.


The following table shows a comparison between May 2020 and 2021city sales tax collections by NAICS category. Sales tax collections from the "remote" retailers represent approximately 9% of the June 2021 city sales tax collections and increased 33% over the prior year. Retail trade continues to be the <u>largest dollar contributor</u> to the monthly increase in city sales tax.



Sales and Use Tax Revenues - Year to Date

Attached is 5 year history of the year-to-date sales and use tax revenues by Category (NAICS).

<u>Community Center Fund – June 2021</u>. City sales and use tax revenues for June reflect a 22% increase from 2020 revenues and charges for services are up 181% from the prior year. Year-to-date combined revenues from taxes and charges for services are up 31% over the prior year (2020) and up 6% when compared to 2019 pre-COVID revenues.





<u>Revenue vs Expense by Account Type – July 2021.</u> This report presents summary information on revenues and expenses and budget comparisons for all funds. The report includes revenues and expenses by type and also by department. The following is a summary of the report by fund showing actual revenues and expenses as a percentage of budget.
