BACKGROUND

<u>Sales, Use Tax and Lodging Tax Revenues – August 2021 Sales.</u>

The following chart provides a comparison of sales, use and lodging tax revenues between 2020 and 2021. Overall tax revenues are up \$865,668 from the prior year and ahead of budgeted amounts by \$1,092,813




The following table shows a comparison between August 2020 and 2021 city sales tax collections by NAICS category. Sales tax collections from the "remote" retailers represent approximately 10% of the August 2021 city sales tax collections and increased 30% over the prior year. Retail trade continues to be the <u>largest dollar contributor</u> to the monthly increase in city sales tax.

Sales tax revenues are up 13% for the month over the same period last year and up 15% year to date. Attached is 5 year history of the year-to-date sales and use tax revenues by Category (NAICS).

<u>Community Center Fund – August 2021.</u> City sales and use tax revenues for August reflect an 18% increase from 2020 revenues (15% YTD) and charges for services are up 80% from the prior year (69% YTD). Year-to-date combined revenues from taxes and charges for services are up 32% over the prior year and up 17% compared to 2019 pre-COVID revenues.





Revenue vs Expense by Account Type – September 2021. This report presents summary information on revenues and expenses and budget comparisons for all funds.
