AGENDA TEXT: RESOLUTION 2022-18 - Incorporating property into the City of Fruita operated and maintained irrigation system (W. Pabor Way)

## BACKGROUND

The Fruita Public Works Department has completed the W. Pabor Way irrigation improvement project which involved the placement of irrigation pipe in an existing open concrete ditch. This resolution accepts this new irrigation line into the City-operated and maintained irrigation system and officially adds the properties served to the city-maintained irrigation system.

## FISCAL IMPACT

The City has just under \$12,000 in improvements to this irrigation system. The addition of these properties to the City-operated and maintained irrigation system will not have a significant impact on revenues but may reduce maintenance expenses. Public works crews have responded to irrigation complaints in this area as lack of property owner maintenance has caused issues for the remainder of users on the ditch.

## APPLICABILITY TO CITY GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The incorporation of the W. Pabor Way irrigation system into the City system provides improvements to the irrigation system and will provide improved services.
