AGENDA TEXT: BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS APPOINTMENT – A request to approve the appointment of Al Conder to the Livability Commission for a three-year term to expire on April of 2025

BACKGROUND

The membership guidelines of the Livability Commission call for a minimum of seven and a maximum of twenty-one members. There are currently nine members on the board, so there is the potential for twelve (12) vacancies on the board. Staff has advertised these vacancies on the City's website and Facebook page for over a year and a half and will continue to do so.

On February 22, 2022, Al Conder submitted his application for appointment. City staff has not received any other applications. Mayor Kincaid and Council Liaison to the board Karen Leonhart interviewed Mr. Conder on March 15, 2022 and subsequently recommend his appointment to the board for a three-year term to expire in April of 2025.

If Al Conder is appointed, there is still the potential for eleven (11) remaining vacancies on the board.
