BACKGROUND

The Fruita Area Chamber of Commerce filed an application for a Special Events Permits to sell malt, vinous and spirituous liquor at the "Wine and Whiskey" Tent at Fruita Fall Festival at the southwest intersection of Aspen Avenue and Mulberry Street on Friday, September 24, 2021 and Saturday, September 25, 2021 from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

On September 2, 2021, the Fruita Chamber notified the City Clerk's Office that they wanted to withdraw their application for a number of reasons related to timing, costs and other logistics.

This item is being placed on the agenda by staff because the public hearing for the Chamber's application was published in the Daily Sentinel on August 30, 2021 to notify the public of the public hearing on the application and a notice poster advertising the same was placed at the location for the event for the same purposes.
