BACKGROUND

The Fruita Area Chamber of Commerce has filed an application for a Special Events Permits to sell beer during the Cornhole Tournament at Fruita Fall Festival at Reed Park located at 250 S. Elm Street on Saturday, September 25, 2021 from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. State law allows nonprofit organizations to apply for a special events liquor permit, and the Fruita City Council adopted Resolution 2011-32, which authorizes the Local Licensing Authority to issue Special Events Permits to qualifying organizations and political candidates without sending the application to the State Authority for approval.

The City of Fruita requires that the applicant submit a narrative addressing specific issues related to the special events permit. The application, narrative, diagram and Fruita Police Department comments are attached.

The diagram of the licensed premises submitted with the application controls the area in which alcohol may be sold or consumed and should be strictly adhered to.

- 1. APPLICANT WILL DISCONTINUE SERVING ALCOHOL AT 5:30 PM ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 2021 AND ALCOHOL WILL SECURED AND REMOVED BY 6:00 PM
- 2. VOLUNTEERS, BOARD MEMBERS, EMPLOYEES AND HIRED SECURITY WILL MONITOR THE ENTRANCES TO THE LICENSED AREAS AND THEIR PERIMETERS TO MAKE SURE NO ALCOHOL COMES INTO OR LEAVES THE LICENSED AREA
- 3. ALL OTHER PROCEDURES PROPOSED BY THE FRUITA AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE WILL BE FOLLOWED AND THE CHAMBER WILL BE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF LIQUOR LAWS
