DESIGNATING 279 NORTH MESA STREET TO THE CITY REGISTER OF HISTORIC SITES, STRUCTURES, AND DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, the Fruita City Council has established, by Ordinance 1997-10, a City Register of Historic Sites, Structures, and Districts in order to recognize historic resources of local significance, and
