BACKGROUND

The Council has directed staff to begin exploring the creation of a down payment assistance program for cost-burdened members of our workforce. As part of that effort, Council sees the value of formally appointing a working group to assist in that effort. Down payment assistance, if implemented correctly, will interact with several private sector partners in mortgage lending, appraisals, development and sales.

This group is set up to capture a vast majority of that representation to ensure the project is vetted correctly. This will be a temporary working group focused solely on the programmatic elements around down payment assistance. It is important to note that this group, in conjunction with staff, will be responsible for making a recommendation to Council. The individuals in this working group and their occupations include:
