A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2025 BUDGET WITH SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF FUNDS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS, CAPITAL EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIES, AND SPECIAL PROJECTS INITIALLY INCLUDED IN THE 2024 ANNUAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, certain capital projects and capital equipment initially budgeted for in the 2024 fiscal year were not completed or purchased as anticipated due to various reasons, and funds need to be re-appropriated in 2025 for completion of these projects or purchase of this equipment, and

WHEREAS, certain capital equipment and special projects are being requested as part of new appropriations, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 8.10 of the Fruita City Charter, the City Manager certifies there are sufficient funds available for the supplemental appropriations as noted below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRUITA, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:
