reappointment of Mel Mulder to the Planning Commission as a regular member for

another three-year term to expire in August of 2027

### **BACKGROUND**

Planning Commission member Mel Mulder's term expires in August of 2024, thus creating a vacancy. The vacancy has been advertised on the City's website at fruita.org and on the City's Facebook page since June 17, 2024 to the present.

On August 8, 2024, Mel Mulder submitted his application for reappointment to the Planning Commission and staff forwarded it to Mayor Breman. Staff has received no other applications for the vacancy. After reviewing Mr. Mulder's application, Mayor Breman recommends that Mr. Mulder be reappointed to the Planning Commission for a three-year term to expire in August of 2027. Mr. Mulder has been made aware that pursuant to the City's Boards and Commissions Policy that was adopted by the City Council on August 4, 2020, if he is reappointed at this Council meeting of August 20, 2024, he is not eligible to serve another consecutive three-year term. Mr. Mulder has been serving on the Fruita City Council since 2006.

Mel Mulder's application is attached for the Council's review. If he is reappointed, there will be no remaining regular member vacancies on the Planning Commission except for two alternate member vacancies.
