

RESOLUTION 2024-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRUITA, COLORADO, APPROVING THE COLORADO OPIOID SETTLEMENT AND RECOVERY – KROGER - AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND/OR MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO FULFILL PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Law has come to an agreement with Colorado’s local governments for distributing opioid settlement and recovery funds to local counties and municipalities; and

WHEREAS, to maximize the settlement funds within Colorado, it is important that all Colorado counties and municipalities participate in these settlements and the distribution process.

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Law, on behalf of the State, has reached a settlement agreement with the Kroger Company for additional funds to be distributed (the “Kroger Settlement”).

WHEREAS, the Kroger Settlement requires municipalities and counties to submit a participation through the firm Rubris on or before August 12, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRUITA, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated as findings by the City Council of the City of Fruita (“City Council”).

Section 2. The City Council approves the Kroger Settlement and authorizes the City Manager and/or Mayor, whichever is required, to execute and submit all required documents to fulfill its participation requirements pursuant to this settlement. Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption hereof.
