BACKGROUND

The Financial Statements for fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, will be presented to the City Council. This overview is intended to provide information on the City's financial condition as of December 31, 2022 and a framework for upcoming discussions regarding the 2024 budget.

The Fiscal Health Analysis (FHA) will also be presented to the City Council for review. The FHA is a set of seven financial ratios developed by the Local Government Audit Division of the Office of the State Auditor to assess financial health. This information can assist the City in identifying areas to focus on for further examination and, if needed, take appropriate action.

Following this presentation, Lisa Hemann, President and Director of Audit Services with Chadwick, Steinkirchner, Davis and Co., PC (CSD) will present the Independent Auditor's Report on the Financial Statements for the City of Fruita at December 31, 2022.
