AGENDA TEXT: BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS APPOINTMENT - A request to approve the

appointment of Carrie Bechtel to the Arts and Culture Board for a three-year term

to expire in October of 2027

BACKGROUND

On July 17, 2024, Arts & Culture Board member Marian Heesaker resigned from the Fruita Arts and Culture Board, thus creating a vacancy.

On September 11, 2024, Carrie Bechtel submitted her application for appointment to either the Livability Commission or the Fruita Arts and Culture Board. On September 17, 2024, Mayor Breman and Council Liaisons Andrea Downs (Arts and Culture Board) and Amy Miller (Livability Commission) interviewed Ms. Bechtel and subsequently recommend her appointment to the Arts and Culture board for a three-year term to expire in October of 2027.

If Ms. Bechtel is appointed, there will be two (2) remaining vacancies on the Arts and Culture Board. One of these vacancies is due to a member's term expiring in November of 2024 and the other when a member's term had already expired. Staff will continue to advertise these vacancies going forward.
