

RESOLUTION NO. R-06-2026

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FULTON ADOPTING THE ARANSAS COUNTY CITY OF ROCKPORT AND TOWN OF FULTON EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN BASIC PLAN DATED SEPTEMBER 2026 AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code establishes a coordinated system of emergency management and requires local jurisdictions to provide for comprehensive emergency management planning; and

WHEREAS, Section 418.106 of the Texas Government Code requires each local emergency management agency to prepare and keep current an emergency management plan for its area; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Fulton participates with Aransas County and the City of Rockport in an interjurisdictional emergency management program pursuant to City of Rockport Ordinance No. 558, adopted March 8, 1982, and the Joint Resolution dated November 9, 1982; and

WHEREAS, the Aransas County, City of Rockport, and Town of Fulton Emergency Management Plan Basic Plan, dated September 2026, establishes an all-hazards framework for preparedness, response, recovery, coordination, continuity, public information, resource management, and plan maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that adoption and implementation of the Basic Plan will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Rockport and will serve a valid public purpose.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FULTON

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals stated above are found to be true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution for all purposes.

SECTION 2. Adoption. The Town Council hereby adopts and approves the Aransas County, City of Rockport, and Town of Fulton Emergency Management Plan Basic Plan, dated September 2026, as the emergency management basic plan applicable to the Town of Fulton. A copy of the Basic Plan shall be maintained in the official records of the Town and is incorporated into this Resolution by reference.

SECTION 3. Authorization and Implementation. The Mayor is authorized to approve and promulgate the Basic Plan on behalf of the City. The Town's emergency management officials, and other appropriate Town personnel are authorized to coordinate with the Aransas County Emergency Management Coordinator and the City of Rockport and to take actions reasonably necessary to implement, administer, maintain, and submit the Basic Plan, subject to applicable law and available appropriations.

SECTION 4. Prior Plans. Upon approval and promulgation by the participating jurisdictions, the September 2026 Basic Plan supersedes prior editions of the emergency management basic plan. Any prior Town resolution or action addressing an earlier edition remains effective only to the extent it does not conflict with this Resolution or the September 2026 Basic Plan.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
