The Garden City Police Department responded in varying capacities to three-hundred and twenty-one (321) calls for service in the last year at the Everyday Store. Many of these calls were related to a deficient security system which has been addressed with staff on multiple occasions. As of last week, it has been the first time that the security system has not been active at least every other night.

The management at Everyday Store has allowed a continued presence of narcotics use and distribution, vagrancy, and a significant amount of littering and general illegal conduct resulting from not managing the populations that use this location as a site of engaging in these actions and illegal activities. The rear dumpster location has served as a continued business site and general area where a substantial number of these activities take place. Management and employees have also ignored activities taken by individuals directly in front of the store to include narcotics use, distribution, and other criminal activity. Ownership, management, and employees fail to include law enforcement or any other community action groups to assist in eliminating access and use of the controlled premise for these illegal actions.

The illegal activities engaged in at the Everyday Store has created a community public nuisance as by definition found under Colorado Revised Statute 16-13-304 - Class 2 Public Nuisance. The police department will monitor the coming year for store conditions that fall under the provisions of public nuisance. Twenty-eight individuals (28) were placed into custody directly on Everyday Store property or were in custody after being originally contacted on property owned by the Everyday Store. The majority of these actions taken by law enforcement were self-initiated due to lack of Everyday Store employees engaging in managing their own location.

There were no violations found during the site inspection of the store.

The Garden City Police Department objects to licensing for this store location for the safety and security concerns listed above.
