The Upper Peninsula Substance Enforcement Team (UPSET) is a multi-jurisdictional narcotics task force committed to the safety and well-being of the citizens in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. UPSET is seeking funding to assist with operating expenses which greatly enhance investigative efforts in your community.

Established in 1988, UPSET started out as a small drug team which primarily arrested drug users and smaller dealers. Today, UPSET has become a driving force for narcotics education, awareness, and enforcement. UPSET consists of multiple federal, state, and local agencies and serves all 15 counties of the Upper Peninsula and by working together as one, the enforcement impact on a community is like no other. UPSET has the only clandestine methamphetamine lab team with specialized training in enforcement and education.
