









What is a Downtown Development Authority (DDA)?

DDAs comprehensively manage downtowns to maximize the local economy. DDAs are downtown management organizations that rely on TIF dollars for their operation Quasi-governmental arm of the City

Goal to halt property value deterioration and increase property tax valuation to eliminate the causes of that deterioration, and to promote economic growth.












Activities of the Board





Beautification

Each year the DDA contracts services with the City of Gladstone's Parks & Recreation Department to oversee beautification efforts in the downtown.











Infrastructure & Street Improvements

The DDA often partners with the City of Gladstone to offset the cost of infrastructure and street improvements within the district



The DDA has an annual bond payment of \$227,000 for the 9th Street project which took place in 2020.

This bond commitment is scheduled to end in the 2033-2034 fiscal year.

This year's bond payment made up 59.7% of our expected 2024-2025 TIF capture. The DDA covered 59.9% of the total \$5,683,402 in project cost. (\$3.4 million)

North Shore Development

The DDA has assisted the City of Gladstone in acquiring undeveloped waterfront within the city limits for future development. This financial commitment ends in the fiscal year 2031-2032.
