Please provide a description of the event.	<p>Saunders Point Brewing is planning a community race event consisting of a 5K and 10K, with proceeds benefiting the Gladstone Girls Volleyball program. The purpose of the event is to create a fun, family-friendly community fundraiser that encourages recreation, supports local youth athletics, and brings participants and visitors into the downtown and waterfront area.</p> <p>The Gladstone Girls Volleyball program will participate as event volunteers, including staffing six water stations positioned along the race route. We also plan to have a designated pacer to help guide participants along the course and support the overall flow of the event. The 10K portion of the course will include a dedicated water station located on the bike and walking path adjacent to the highway, known as the Little Bay de Noc Trail.</p> <p>Participation will be capped at 250 runners. There will be no age restriction for participation.</p> <p>We are also coordinating with Dairy Flo to provide a post-race treat for participants under the age of 21 in the form of a gift certificate. Participants age 21 and older will receive an item from Saunders Point Brewing following the race.</p> <p>Following the race, we would like to host an outdoor post-race celebration within the street closure area. This portion of the event will be open to the public and will include live outdoor music from 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.</p> <p>Race Route Description</p> <p>The race will begin at the intersection of 9th Street and Superior Avenue and proceed east toward Saunders Point and the campground area. Participants will continue through the campground, following the roadway to Minneapolis Avenue, and then continue along Lakeshore Drive toward 11th Street.</p> <p>For the 5K route, participants will cross Lakeshore Drive at 11th Street and proceed north on 11th Street. From there, runners will head east on Minneapolis Avenue to 10th Street, then continue north using the parking lane on the west side of 10th Street. The race will finish at the intersection of 10th Street and Delta Avenue.</p> <p>For the 10K route, participants will follow the same initial route to the intersection of 11th Street and Lakeshore Drive. At that point, 10K runners will continue farther along Lakeshore Drive and then use the bike and walking path adjacent to the highway, known as the Little Bay de Noc Trail. A dedicated water station will be located along this portion of the route before runners return to the intersection of 11th Street and Lakeshore Drive. From there, they will cross Lakeshore Drive, proceed north on 11th Street, continue east on Minneapolis Avenue to 10th Street, and then head north in the parking lane on the west side of 10th Street to the finish line at 10th Street and Delta Avenue.</p> <p>Requested City Assistance</p> <p>To safely host the event, we are requesting the following assistance and accommodations from the City of Gladstone:</p> <p>Closure of 10th Street between Saunders Point Brewing and Dairy Flo from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Assistance from Public Safety at the intersection of 9th Street and Superior Avenue at the 10:00 a.m. race start for approximately 15 minutes to safely manage the crossing during the start of the race Assistance at the intersection of 11th Street and Lakeshore Drive, ideally in the form of a crossing guard or similar traffic support, to help ensure safe runner passage Temporary blocking of the parking spaces on the west side of 10th Street along the final portion of the race route so runners have a protected path to the finish line</p> <p>Community Benefit</p> <p>We believe this event will provide a meaningful fundraising opportunity for a local school program while creating a safe and engaging community event for participants, spectators, and the public.
