

Gladstone Bay Campground is operated under the jurisdiction of the Director of Parks and Recreation or designated representatives. The Parks and Recreation staff, as well as Gladstone Public Safety, will enforce these Policies and Regulations.

### Reservations

- You must be 18 years old or older to make a reservation.
- The person making the reservation is the party responsible for the campsite.
- Subleasing a site is prohibited.
- **All reservations must be paid in full at the time of reservation.**

### Form of Payment

- The following forms of payment are accepted: cash, personal check, cashier's check, money order or credit card (Visa, Mastercard, Discover and American Express).
- **A 3% service fee will be added to all credit card payments.**

### Cancellation Policy:

- Cancellations made seven (7) days or less prior to check-in, the total amount paid is forfeited (non-refundable).
- Cancellations made eight (8) days or more prior to check-in, full refund minus the daily fee for that site.
- If a guest decides to leave early for any reason during their camping stay or if Administration deems it necessary to terminate the camping stay for any reason, there is no refund.

**Check-in time:** 1:00 PM EST

**Check-out time:** 12:00 PM EST

**Quiet Hours:** 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM EST

### Safety

- The campground reserves the right to refuse service to anyone not adhering to these rules.
- Any threatening language or physical/verbal abuse towards fellow campers, staff, or city employees will not be tolerated
- Fireworks are prohibited from being used in the campground.
- No bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, or scooters are to be ridden around or under breezeway of the restroom/shower facility.
- There is no lifeguard on duty at the campground. Swim at your own risk. Protective footwear is recommended. For lifeguard protected swimming, please visit Gladstone Beach during lifeguard's posted hours.

### Campfires

- Fires are only permitted in the designated fire rings provided by the campground.
- Cans, glass, and other non-flammable debris are not permitted in fire rings.
- Disposing of food in fire rings is prohibited.
- Disposing of garbage in fire rings is prohibited.
- Fires must not be left unattended.
- Extinguish all fires before leaving.

### Campsite Maintenance

- Campers are responsible for keeping the campsite clean.
- Garbage shall not be permitted to accumulate and should be properly disposed of each day. All garbage shall be properly enclosed in garbage bags and placed in the dumpster provided by the campground. Only dumping of waste generated on site is allowed.
- Campers are responsible for their belongings. The City of Gladstone is not responsible for missing valuables or damage to your personal property through malicious destruction by others or by acts of God.
- Splitters are illegal to use below vacuum breakers.
- All routine maintenance of the campsite will be done by the campground staff.

### Parking

- Maximum of two (1) vehicles allowed per campsite. Additional parking for guests is available at the entrance to the park.
- Park campers on designated pad.

### Grey/Black Water and Dump Station

- Campers must use the dump station or a tote. **ABSOLUTELY NO DUMPING OF GREY/BLACK WATER ON SITE OR SURROUNDING AREA. PENALTY WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EVICTION FROM CAMPGROUND WITH NO REFUND.**

### Pets

- Pets are welcome in the campground.
- Pets must be kept on a leash no longer than six (6) feet in length when walking through the campground or on a leash that contains the pet to the campsite of the owner. The pet must be under handler's immediate control at all times.
- Pets should not be left unattended.
- Pet owners shall immediately pick up all waste from their pet and ensure they do not disturb other campers.
