Agenda Item Title:

Special Event Permit | Delta Conservation District 75th Anniversary

Background:

The Delta Conservation District has submitted a request to host its 75th Anniversary Celebration on **August 26, 2026**, in collaboration with Saunders Point Brewing. The public community event will include educational and vendor booths, live music, and activities recognizing the organization's service to Delta County. The applicant is requesting temporary closure of North 10th Street from the north side of Delta Avenue to the adjacent alley from approximately 1:00 PM to 8:00 PM to accommodate canopies, booths, entertainment space, and pedestrian access. Event activities are scheduled from 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM, with estimated attendance of approximately 250 people.

The event is proposed within the Downtown Social District, with beverages limited to those purchased from licensed Social District establishments. The applicant indicated no generators or cooking equipment will be utilized, restroom access will be available through Saunders Point Brewing, and existing Social District trash receptacles will be used. Staff has discussed coordination needs related to barricades and street closure logistics with the applicant. A copy of the application request is attached for Commission review and consideration.
