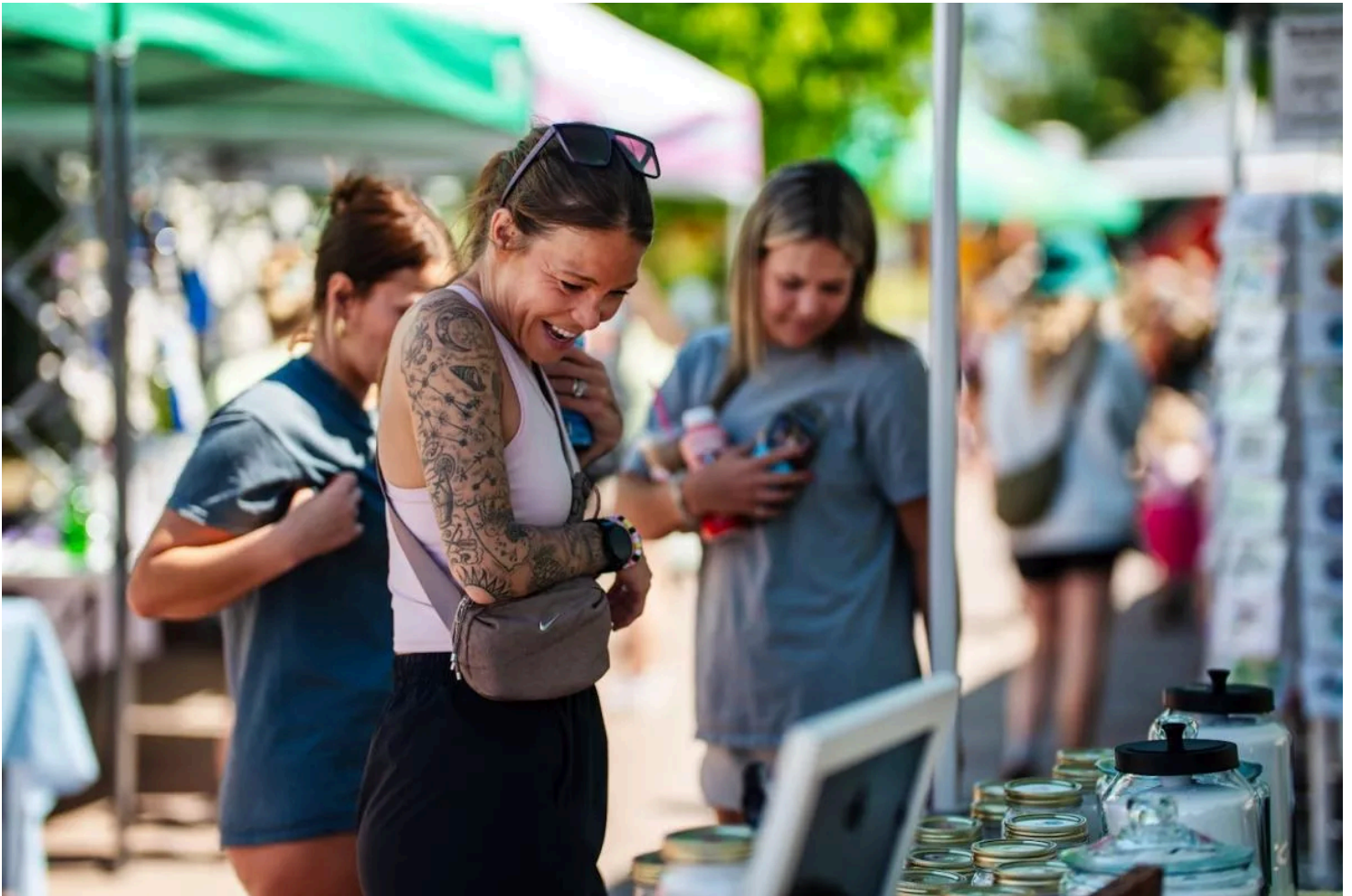


Gladstone Expands Commitment to Placemaking Through MEDC MiPlace Partnership
