SUMMARY: For some reason, the City's Historic Landmark Preservation Ordinance (HLPO) was codified as Article 3.16 of the City's Code of Ordinances in Building Regulations. The authority for this ordinance is found in Chapter 211 "Municipal Zoning Authority" of the Texas Local Government Code. This ordinance recodifies HLPO as part of the City's Zoning Ordinance. Also, this Ordinance would allow a volunteer to serve as the Historic Preservation Officer (currently only staff can serve), authorize the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) to submit recommendations on filling board vacancies, remove the 3 consecutive term board member limitation, and charge the HPC with oversight of the Farmer's Market. This ordinance has been reviewed and approved by the P&Z and the HPC.			
RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt the Ordinance as presented.
