SUMMARY:	<p>County Commissioner Jeff Harris had been asked about having a fourth stop sign installed at Walnut and Vernon Streets. After discussing the matter with Harris, a sketch was prepared, detailing an installation similar to the one done a few years ago at the intersection of Elm and Vernon. Public Works Director Holder estimates this project will cost about \$3,500. Staff met with Commissioner Harris to show him where the stop sign and associated island would be installed. This stop sign should help slow down motorists heading east on Vernon toward the Post Office. Commissioner Harris approved the proposal that is now being presented to the Council.</p>
