SUMMARY:	<p>This proposal is to be able to make sure emergency vehicles can get down Glen Rose Residential streets. The Fire Chief has stated that the fire trucks need a minimum of 12' to get down the streets. Some of our residential streets are only 20' wide. If vehicles are parked on both sides of the street, then emergency vehicles will not have access to emergencies. It is proposed that residential streets less than 22' wide could only have street parking on one side of street. Any streets less than 18' wide should have no street parking.</p>
