The Tourism Specialist also assists in managing communications, preparing mailings, and assembling promotional items and welcome materials to enhance visitor engagement and satisfaction.

- Greets and Assists all guests entering the Visitor's Center in a friendly and professional manner
- Provides printed brochures, maps, and other tourism-related materials to visitors
- Answers questions and provides accurate information about local landmarks, history, dining, shopping, events, and area attractions
- Answers, screens, and returns incoming phone calls to the Visitor's Center; directs calls as needed
- Prepares and mails Visitor Guides and tourism information packets upon request
- Assembles promotional items, welcome bags, and other materials for special events, groups, or promotional use

- Assists with the inventory and restocking of printed materials and promotional supplies
