<b>SUMMARY:</b>	<p>Staff has been working with Somervell County Water District General Manager Kevin Taylor to create a plan to allow SCWD to provide water service to Squaw Valley Meadows Subdivision since they already have adequate service in that area and if the City were to serve the area it would have to run a water main from the west side of the Highways 67 and 144 intersection all the way to the subdivision. The attached Interlocal Cooperation Agreement achieves that goal, although staff has some reservations about a portion of that agreement. Those reservations are presented in the attached discussion sheet. City Attorney Pendleton has reviewed the agreement and recommends <i>"or are readily serviceable from the District's network of water mains"</i> be stricken from section "1" of the agreement.</p>
