DESIGN GUIDELINES

3. PROCEDURE TO OBTAIN DESIGNATION AS A CITY OF GRANBURY HISTORIC LANDMARK OR A HISTORIC DISTRICT

- 1. Complete a Historic Landmark Zoning Petition application.
- 2. Submit a completed application to the Community Development Department 10 days before the Historic Preservation Commission's meeting date.
- **3.** The meeting dates for the Historic Preservation Commission are generally the second and fourth Thursdays of each month at 4:30 p.m.
- **4.** You will be asked to pay a \$50 filing fee according to the Master Fee Schedule with your application.
- **5.** You will be notified prior to the Commission's hearing on your application. At the hearing, you may present testimony or documentary evidence on the importance of the proposed historic landmark or district.
- 6. If the Commission recommends your property for designation as a historic landmark, or your neighborhood for designation as a historic district, its recommendation will be submitted to the Planning & Zoning Commission within 30 days of your final application.
- 7. The Planning & Zoning Commission will provide public notice and hold a hearing on your application within 45 days. After its meeting, the Planning & Zoning Commission will make its recommendation to the City Council within 45 days.
- **8.** The City Council will schedule a hearing on the Planning & Zoning Commission's recommendation within 45 days.
- **9.** If the City Council votes to recognize your building as a historic landmark or your neighborhood as a historic district, the designation will be recorded with the County, City and the Tax Appraisal District. All zoning maps will indicate the designated historic landmarks or districts.
- 10. If the City Council votes to recognize your building as a historic landmark or your neighborhood as a historic district, you will have to pay for your landmark plaque, what is the history of this statement the commission has been historically paying for landmark plaque.

Criteria for Granbury Historic Landmarks and Granbury Historic Districts

A property or neighborhood can be awarded designation as a Granbury Historic Landmark or a Granbury Historic District if it meets one or more of the following criteria:

- 1. Has been recognized as a Recorded Texas Historic Landmark or has been entered into the National Register of Historic Places.
- 2. Possesses significance in history, architecture, archeology, and culture.
- 3. Is associated with the lives of persons significant in our past.
- **4.** Embodies the distinctive characteristics of a type, period, or method of construction.
- 5. Represents an established and familiar visual feature of the City.
