

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLEN ROSE, TEXAS, FORMALLY ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4,000) FROM THE LDL FOUNDATION AND THE SOMERVELL HISTORY FOUNDATION TO SUPPORT THE CITY AND SOMERVELL COUNTY IN THEIR EFFORTS RELATED TO OPPOSING THE PROPOSED ONCOR TRANSMISSION ROUTE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND AUTHORIZING ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Glen Rose, Texas (“City”), is actively engaged in coordination with Somervell County and other stakeholders regarding matters related to the proposed Oncor transmission line routes; and

WHEREAS, the LDL Foundation and the Somervell History Foundation have expressed their support for the City’s and County’s efforts to evaluate, respond to, and oppose the proposed “Route 3” alignment; and

WHEREAS, the LDL Foundation and the Somervell History Foundation have jointly offered a monetary donation in the amount of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) to assist the City and County in activities, research, representation, or other actions related to this matter; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that accepting this donation is in the best interest of the City and will support ongoing efforts to protect the community, its residents, and its historical, cultural, and environmental assets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLEN ROSE, TEXAS, THAT:

The City of Glen Rose hereby formally accepts the donation of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) from the LDL Foundation and the Somervell History Foundation.

The City Council expresses its appreciation to both organizations for their support and commitment to the community.

The City Administrator, or their designee, is authorized to deposit the funds into the appropriate account and to coordinate with Somervell County regarding the use of these funds for efforts related to the proposed Oncor Route 3.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
