

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-0-03

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO-PARKING ZONE ON WALNUT STREET FROM GRACE STREET TO THE PALUXY RIVER; PROVIDING FOR A FINE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glen Rose, Texas (“City”) finds that regulating parking on certain streets is necessary to protect public safety, ensure adequate traffic flow, and maintain emergency access; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that parking along Walnut Street from Grace Street to the river impedes visibility, restricts roadway access, and creates unsafe conditions for motorists and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the public to establish a designated no-parking zone along this segment of Walnut Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLEN ROSE, TEXAS:

Section 1. No-Parking Zone Established.

Parking is hereby prohibited on Walnut Street from Grace Street to the Paluxy River, a distance of approximately 55 feet. This segment shall be designated as a No Parking Zone.

Section 2. Signage.

The City Manager or their designee is authorized and directed to install appropriate signage indicating the no-parking restriction described in Section 1.

Section 3. Offense and Penalty.

Any person who parks a vehicle in violation of this ordinance commits a civil offense and shall be subject to a fine in an amount not to exceed the maximum amount allowed by law. Each day is a separate violation.

Section 4. Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval as required by law.
