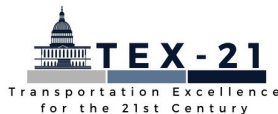

This fiscal year has been successful for TEX-21, as we have transitioned out of the virtual-only age of the COVID pandemic back into in-person meetings. Thanks to your membership and support, this fiscal year we have been able to host edifying Statewide meetings in Granbury, Houston, Jefferson County, Tarrant County, and San Antonio. At each meeting, we had the privilege of hearing from a number of great speakers who brought a wealth of information. If your entity is like mine, your fiscal year begins on October 1 and ends on September 30, and coincides with TEX-21's fiscal year.
