The application will be presented to and voted upon by the Glen Rose City Council as outlined in Section 8.01.001 of the City of Glen Rose Code of ordinances. This application will either be approved, approved with conditions, denied, or more information may be requested by the Glen Rose City Council. In the event requiring a street closure, applications must be submitted no less than ninety (90) days in advance. Due to Texas Department of Transportation requirements, closure of any state highway for more than six (6) hours will require sixty (60) days notification to the City. You will be notified in writing or by telephone of the application outcome, following the scheduled City Council meeting in which this application is addressed.

Request for Special Events Application citing special circumstances for participation requiring gender or age discrimination must be accompanied by an exceedingly persuasive justification.
6. If necessary, the applicant will furnish a map showing the area where the special event is to be conducted.
7. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited except in designated areas only.

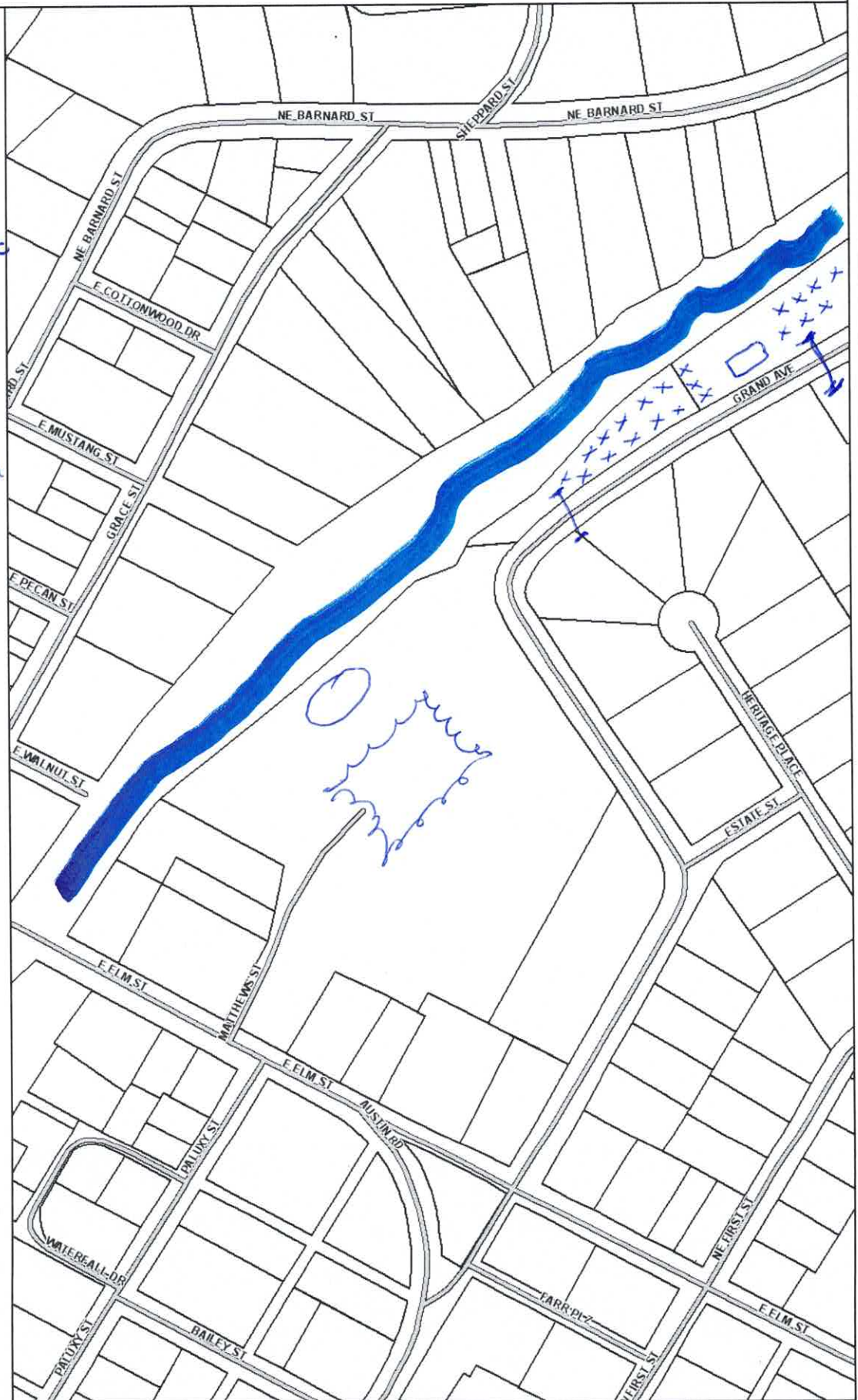
