RESOLUTION TO CLOSE A PORTION OF MESQUITE STREET AND
EXECUTE QUIT-CLAIM DEED TO ADJACENT OWNERS

At the ~~xx~~ Called meeting of the City Council of the City of Glen Rose, Texas, held on the 4th day of October, A.D. 1966, on motion duly made, seconded and carried, the following Resolution was adopted:

Whereas, there is no record in the City or County records showing Mesquite Street as platted or dedicated between Cedar Street on the Northeast and Hereford Street on the Southwest, and

Whereas, application has been made to this Council by G.C. Gibbs, Jr., to close the Northeast 200 feet of said Street, which if opened would run through property owned by him as he owns property on both sides of that portion of said Street, and

Whereas, said Street has never been opened to or used by the public.

Now Therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Glen Rose, Somervell County, Texas, that said Mesquite Street between Cedar Street and Hereford Street be abandoned and closed and that Walter Ernst, Mayor, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute a Quit-Claim Deed to said G.C. Gibbs, Jr., Trustee, covering the Northeast 200 feet of said Mesquite Street, and to Mrs. E.L. Adams and V.J. Maloney covering the Southwest 200 feet of said Mesquite Street.
