

RESOLUTION 2022-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLEN ROSE, TEXAS DECLARING THAT EACH CANDIDATE WHOSE NAME IS TO APPEAR ON THE GENERAL BALLOT IS UNOPPOSED, THAT NO PROPOSITION APPEARS ON THE BALLOT; DECLARING THAT EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ON THE GENERAL BALLOT IS ELECTED THAT OFFICE; AND RESCINDING THE RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE MAY 7, 2022, GENERAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, on the 31st day of January 2022, the City Council of the City of Glen Rose, Texas duly called for an election to be held on May 7, 2022, for the election of three (3) Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 143.007 and 146.054, Texas Election Code, the deadline for filing applications for a place on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy for the City's regular municipal election has expired; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy City Secretary, in accordance with Section 2.052, Texas Election Code has certified in writing to the City Council that TJ Walker, George A. Freas, and Kelly K. Harris are unopposed for three (3) Councilmember positions; and

WHEREAS, the Glen Rose City Council hereby finds and determines that the candidates whose names are to appear on the ballot in said election for three (3) Councilmembers are unopposed, there are no declared write-in candidates, and there are no propositions to appear on the ballot for said May 7, 2022 election;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLEN ROSE, TEXAS:

That pursuant to Section 2.053(b), Texas Election Code, the regular municipal election for the three (3) Councilmembers heretofore called and ordered for May 7, 2022, shall not be held and is hereby canceled.

That in accordance with Section 2.053(a), Texas Election Code, the following unopposed candidates: TJ Walker, George A. Freas, and Kelly K. Harris are duly elected to serve as Councilmembers on the City Council of the City of Glen Rose, Texas and shall be issued a certificate of election following the date on which the regular municipal election for Councilmembers for the City of Glen Rose was to have been held.

That the Deputy City Secretary is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution to be posted on Election Day, same being May 7, 2022 at each of the polling places that would have been used in the election.
