<b>SUMMARY:</b>	<p>The City's contract with Republic Services for Municipal Solid Waste Services expires at the end of 2022. An RFP for Municipal Solid Waste Collection services was prepared and presented to the committee appointed by the Council. At the suggestion of committee members some changes were made. The final product is attached for your review. One item that has been addressed in the RFP is the timing for consumer price index triggered price increases. The city would be notified of any increase during the City's budget process and the increase would become effective on October 1st, the first day of the City's new fiscal year. Since there was some controversy when the City went from twice a week to once a week collections, an alternate for twice a week residential collections has been included. The proposal includes a quarterly bulky item collection. With this increase in bulky item collections, staff is hopeful the Council will be amenable to eliminating the monthly operation of the Convenience Station. After discussion with someone in the industry, penalties for various performance failures were added as tools to ensure dependable service. As you will see, the RFP is very detailed with the intent of avoiding the controversy encountered the last time the City went through this process.</p>
