SUMMARY:	<p>The City has control of 82 of the 5,000 votes to be cast in the election for the SCAD Board of Directors for 2022-2023. The number of votes each taxing authority is awarded is determined by the amount of the entity's property tax revenue. Since most of the other taxing entities within Somervell County have taxing districts which encompass the nuclear power plant, the City's property tax revenue is relatively small, thus the low number of votes under the City's control. At its September meeting, the Council nominated Jim Bob Hawthorne as a candidate for the SCAD's 2022-2023 Board of Directors. The Council now needs to cast its votes via the attached resolution. It may cast all of its votes for one candidate or divide them between different candidates.</p>
