



## CITY OF GRAND PRAIRIE RESOLUTION

**PRESENTER:** Caryl DeVries, P.E., PTOE, Director of Transportation and Mobility

**TITLE:** An amended Resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into an Advance Funding Agreement (AFA) with the State of Texas through the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) to rebuild the traffic signal and make other improvements at the intersection of Great Southwest Parkway and Marshall Drive. The estimated total construction cost of the project is \$751,406, which will be 100% federally funded. The City is responsible for funding an estimated \$61,703 in direct state costs, as well as engineering design costs and 100% of any project cost overruns

### **PURPOSE OF REQUEST:**

On December 16, 2025, Council approved Resolution #5514-2025, which allowed the City Manager to execute an Advanced Funding Agreement (AFA) for traffic signal improvements at the intersection of Great Southwest Parkway and Marshall Drive. Since the passage of the resolution, the Texas Department of Transportation- Fort Worth District has revised the resolution requirements so that specific dollar amounts for the project are not included in the resolution. The amended resolution includes only the percentage of Federal and Local funding for the project.

## **BODY**

**AN AMENDED RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRAND PRAIRIE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DEPUTY CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT (AFA) WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF GREAT SOUTHWEST PARKWAY AND MARSHALL DRIVE PROJECT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, on August 22, 2024, via Minute Order 116752, the Texas Transportation Commission authorized traffic signal improvements at the intersection of Great Southwest Parkway and Marshall Drive project (the “Project”) to receive 100% Federal funds from the Highway Safety Improvement Program for traffic signal improvements at the intersection of Great Southwest Parkway and Marshall Drive project and Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) oversight; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Grand Prairie commits to provide the match for the Project. The local match is comprised of Transportation Development Credits in lieu of the Local Government’s 10% match contribution; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Grand Prairie is responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100% of cost overruns, if any; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Grand Prairie desires to reaffirm its support of the Project, approve and authorize the execution of an Advance Funding Agreement (AFA) with TxDOT for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution replaces Resolution #5514-2025.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRAND PRAIRIE, TEXAS THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or Deputy City Manager is authorized to enter into an AFA with TxDOT for the Project.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall be and become effective immediately upon and after its adoption and approval.
