TITLE: Authorize the City Manager or designee to negotiate and execute a Second Amendment to the Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with the City of Irving relating to water and wastewater services for areas west of North Belt Line Road, south of Rock Island Road and north of Entertainment Way; Authorize the expenditure of an amount up to \$150,000 to fund the replacement and repair of Irving's large Water and Wastewater commercial meters servicing customers in Grand Prairie

PURPOSE OF REQUEST:

The purpose of this request is to authorize the City Manager or designee to negotiate and execute a Second Amendment to the Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with the City of Irving for water and wastewater service. The Second Amendment to the existing ILA will clarify the water/wastewater, wastewater-only, and water-only service areas within Grand Prairie west of North Belt Line Road and South of Hunter Ferrell Road that are being served by the City of Irving for existing and future developments.

The ILA provides a basis for the City of Grand Prairie to send the agreed-upon amount of the monthly wastewater fees to the City of Irving for wastewater-only service areas. The water/wastewater and water-only service areas will be billed directly by the City of Irving.

As part of the recent negotiations regarding the Interlocal Agreement, the cities have agreed that Irving will provide water only to some of the areas west of N Belt Line Road and South of E. Trinity Blvd (See Beltline South Service Area map attached). Grand Prairie will be servicing the water in the areas west of N. Belt Line Road that are not marked in blue on the map.

Three of Irving's large commercial meters on Belt Line Road that service Grand Prairie have degraded significantly since the Parties entered into the First Amended ILA in 2014. Under the Second Amendment, the parties have agreed to a 50/50 split of the cost of the repairs and/or replacement of the meters, which would be an amount not to exceed \$150,000 for the City of Grand Prairie.

This Second Amendment does not change any of the rates for water or wastewater services for the City of Grand Prairie or any third-party water or wastewater customers.
