### **PURPOSE OF REQUEST:**

Current Solid Waste regulations place a heavy responsibility on landfills to reduce fugitive windblown materials. Large industrial-strength litter fencing can be moved with the blade of either a dozer or a compactor. This allows operators to surround the active face of the landfill daily, preventing small wind-blown items from disbursing to the surrounding areas. These fences typically last approximately 10 years. This purchase will replace fencing from 2013 while providing some additional fencing for improved coverage. A total of ten (10) mobile litter fences are expected to be purchased.
