SUMMARY:

The City’s Standards of Conduct for Officers and Employees (Code of Ethics) are set forth in Article IV of the City Code of Ordinances. Section 2-63 prohibits Unethical Activity and Section 2-65 authorizes the City Council to decide whether a member of the Council has failed to comply with these Standards.

BODY

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRAND PRAIRIE, TEXAS, PUBLICLY REPRIMANDING CITY COUNCILMEMBER MIGUEL “MIKE” DEL BOSQUE

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 2 of the Home Rule Charter for the City of Grand Prairie bestows in the City Council the power to enact and enforce all ordinances necessary to preserve and enforce good government; and

WHEREAS, the City of Grand Prairie has long-standing Standards of Conduct for its officers and employees as set forth in Chapter 2, Article IV of the Code of Ordinances, City of Grand Prairie; and

WHEREAS, the Standards of Conduct provide in part, in section 2-63, that no officer or employee of the city shall engage in any outside activities, or any other conduct, which will reflect discredit upon the city; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2025, Councilmember Miguel “Mike” Del Bosque engaged in a public altercation, at a property located in the 600 block of N. Carrier Parkway, Grand Prairie, TX 75050, that reflected discredit upon the City of Grand Prairie.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND PRAIRIE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby finds that the recitals above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution as if written herein.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby determines that City Councilmember Miguel “Mike” Del Bosque failed to comply with Chapter 2, Article IV, section 2-63 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Grand Prairie, by having engaged in an outside activity and conduct that reflected discredit upon the City.

SECTION 3. City Councilmember Miguel “Mike” Del Bosque is hereby publicly reprimanded.

SECTION 4. This Resolution does not carry legal penalties. This Resolution is limited in scope and should not be interpreted to affect any pending investigatory matters or regulatory proceedings.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval in accordance with the Charter and Code of Ordinances of the City of Grand Prairie, and it is accordingly resolved.
