

History to Current

- \$700/\$800 resident/non and \$10 mile
- The last rate change was 2004, \$500 from 1999-2003
- No disposable cost recovery (some calls \$375 or more)
- Data Collection/HIPAA Compliance/PHI Compliance/ Billing/Collections/Appeals/Fed-State reports all internal
- Cost per transport is \$357
- Senate Bill 2476




Moving Forward

- Modernize billing recovery based on treatment
- Capture disposables and oxygen
- The majority of cost recovery increase is commercial insurance
- Billing/Collections/Appeals outsourced
- Prepared for population growth and no additional staff
- New cost per transport will be \$469
- Additional cost recovery will be { \$1 million } +-
